Thank you for standing alongside Keep Austin Beautiful and helping us create lasting change in our community. Since 1985, we have harnessed the power of passionate volunteers and supporters like you to enhance neighborhoods and preserve the natural beauty of Greater Austin. Your generosity continues to make a profound impact, enabling us to educate, empower, and inspire action for a cleaner and greener city.

In 2024, the Keep Austin Beautiful team and 9,286 committed volunteers dedicated 19,671 hours to improving our community. We removed an incredible 78 tons of litter and recycling, revitalized 321 miles of public spaces. In addition, we educated 12,804 K-12 students on how to recycle, compost, reduce waste, and protect our waterways, empowering the next generation of environmental stewards.

Community Engagement Programs

Community Cleanups

Keep Austin Beautiful engages thousands of volunteers annually to clear litter in the Greater Austin Area through our Community Cleanups program. In 2024, a total of **2,441 volunteers** participated in our efforts to clean neighborhood parks, trails, and streets throughout the city, contributing **5,656 hours of service**.

Clean Lady Bird Lake

Since 2009, Keep Austin Beautiful has organized large-scale, bimonthly cleanups of Lady Bird Lake. With the help of kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddle boards, volunteers clean up both on the water and along the shoreline. In 2024, the Clean Lady Bird Lake program engaged **1,856 volunteers** and removed **23,167 pounds of trash and recycling** from the river.

Keep Austin Beautiful Day

In celebration of Earth Month every April, Keep Austin Beautiful mobilizes thousands of volunteers for an amazing community service event called Keep Austin Beautiful Day. In 2024, a remarkable **3,068 volunteers** from **all ten City Council Districts** came together to clean and beautify their neighborhoods, successfully removing more than **21 tons of trash and recyclable materials** from Austin's streets, parks, and waterways.

Adopt-a-Creek

The Adopt-a-Creek program enables Austinites to take on the role of stewards for their local creeks and waterways, offering resources, education, and professional support. In 2024, the program engaged **2,863 volunteers**, revitalized **84 miles of waterways**, and successfully removed **63,109 pounds of trash and recyclables** from our creeks.



Generation Zero


Generation Zero is an award-winning youth education initiative, developed in partnership with Austin Resource Recovery. This program involves K-12 students in hands-on activities that promote awareness of recycling, composting, and conservation. In 2024, through a combination of in-person and at-home lesson plans, Generation Zero inspired **11,049 Austin youth** to take control of their future by implementing straightforward waste reduction solutions.

Clean Creek Campus

In partnership with the City of Austin Watershed Protection Department, Clean Creek Campus offers engaging, science-based activities for students in grades 3 - 8, linking classroom learning to local environmental challenges and solutions. Participants engage in activities such as litter cleanups, seedball creation, studying macroinvertebrates, and identifying both native and invasive plant species. In 2024, Keep Austin Beautiful reached **1,835 students** through the Clean Creek Campus program.




